Open to everyone. Children under 10 years of age must be accompanied by a parent or guardian 16 years of age or older. Check with the facility for information on minimum height requirements and swimming skill level for children over 10 years of age.

SS - Senior Swim Open to older adults who prefer a more relaxed atmosphere.

TS - Therapeutic Swim Ideal for older adults or persons with sore muscles, back pain, or arthritis.

YS - Youth Swim
Open to youths 12 to 16 years of age.

Swimming provides an excellent opportunity to make new friends and have fun. Please bring your assistants with you. Pools marked with $\mathcal{E}$ are accessible to those with special needs.
